Happy April!

ButterflyMX information-

The building access system soon to be installed is called ButterflyMX. This system will allow us to grant access to residents and their visitors in a more timely and secure manner by way of a unique passcode assigned to each designated family member. Note: Residents will receive a fob.

- A time stamped photo will be taken of all residents and visitors entering the building via the main entrance.
- Visitors who do not have a passcode will enter by way of calling one of our team members from this system. This is similar to the current process, though broader access to call options will support a timelier entrance.
- Residents with a smart phone (Apple or Android) will have the option of accepting a face-to-face call with any visitor at the door prior to allowing them entrance, or they may choose to accept a standard phone call (as they do with the current system) and using the number 9 on their telephone keypad to unlock the door from their phone.
- I will roll this upgrade out in stages, as outlined below:
 - o Stage One: Introduction to Residents.
 - o Stage Two: Invitation to Resident Representative/Emergency Contact.
 - o Stage Three: Adding of Additional Visitors.

In closing, I want this transition to be as easy for you as possible. Please do not hesitate to reach out with questions along the way.
